This is a one-time scholarship for \$500. It is open to seniors only. The scholarship can be used for anything the winner chooses.

Only the information on the form and the essay are required to apply for this scholarship. It will be awarded directly to the winning student.

Applicants must submit a 500 word historical essay on the topic of "What it means to be a Freemason."

All applications should be turned into the guidance counselor no later than April 17, 2020.
