

Scholarship Memo #5

Camp Nathanael Scholarship

Qualifications:

1. Applicants must be a professing Christian who consistently conducts themselves in a moral and ethical way that coincides with their faith.
2. Applicant must have attended Camp Nathanael for at least three weeks of resident camp as a students.
3. Applicant must complete the required application by the established deadline.
4. Applicant must be enrolled as a full time student (minimum of 12 semester hours) in an institution of higher education.
5. Applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 and acceptable scores on a college entrance exam.
6. Applicant must maintain a GPA of 3.0 over a two semester period to retain eligibility for the scholarship.
7. Applicant must be available to meet two times per year with representatives of Camp Nathanael Scholarship while benefiting from the scholarship.

Applicants must contact Camp Nathanael directly to receive the scholarship applications.

Camp Nathanael has established the following expectations for the request letter/email from all who inquire about the scholarship:

Your email or letter should include the following:

1. A few sentences explaining how you qualify to apply (how many years of camp attendance, what county, how camp has influenced you).
2. A similar paragraph describing how the scholarship will benefit you in your college experience.

3. A statement requesting an application packet.

Deadline: Completed application packets must be received by Camp Nathanael no later than February 1, 2018.
