Harlan County Farm Bureau Scholarship (County Level Scholarship)

Amount: 1,500.00-(\$750.00 Fall Semester, \$750.00 Spring Semester)

Must have a current paid membership to Farm Bureau.

Must remain a Farm Bureau member as long as the scholarship is in force.

Deadline: April 13, 2018.

Student must follow submission instructions on the application, by either mailing in, or taking the completed application to the Harlan County Farm Bureau Office. ---If items are missing, applications will be disqualified.

Applications are available in the guidance office.

Harlan County Farm Bureau Agent's Scholarship

To be eligible to apply the applicant must:

- Have a paid current membership
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA and a minimum 20 ACT score.
- Finish high school within the year applied for in the application and must remain a Farm Bureau member as long as the scholarship is in force.

Amount: \$500.00

Deadline: Application must be submitted to the Harlan County Farm Bureau office no later than April 13, 2018.

Student must follow submission instructions on the application, by either mailing in, or taking the completed application to the Harlan County Farm Bureau Office. ---If items are missing, applications will be disqualified.

Applications are available in the guidance office.

Mission of Hope Scholarship

Criteria: It is the desire of the Mission of Hope that students with the greatest financial need be considered for the scholarships. Any student with a 2.5 GPA, and who demonstrates excellent potential and character, work experience, along with financial need may apply for this scholarship. One scholarship will be awarded to a student, the student must maintain an overall grade point average along with completing 12 credit hours per semester in order to keep the scholarship for the following semester.

Amount: \$2500.00.

Deadline: Applications must be returned to your high school counselor by March 2, 2018.

Applications are available in the guidance office.

Harlan County Community Scholarship

Deadline: March 23, 2018. Applications and required supporting documentation should be completed and returned to the HCHS guidance office by the end of the day on Friday, March 23, 2018.

Applicants will be judged on the following criteria: Promise as a Leader in the Job Field/Community, Defined College/Career Plans, Letters of Reference, High School Performance (ACT, GPA, and Rank).

******In addition to applying for the Harlan Community Scholarship, eligible students may also apply for three additional scholarships on the same application form. These scholarship are as follows:**

Fred and Betty Jo Shotton Haas Scholarship (Student must have Lynch High School Connection)

Robert E. Frazier Tri City Area Scholarship (2 male and 2 female Tri City area students graduating from HCHS or HHS)

Robert E. Frazier Tri City Area Scholarship (Need Based for 5 Tri City area students from HCHS). If applying for this scholarship student must submit an additional essay and additional documentation in the form of a W-2 illustrating the need for financial support.

Upper Cumberland Counseling Association Scholarship

Amount: A one-time payment of \$500 applied to the student's account at the recipient's college of choice.

Deadline: March 2, 2018. Applications should be returned to the address on the application by the deadline listed above.

Criteria: College bound seniors who plan to major in the area of human services. Some sample majors within the human services field are: counseling, sociology, education (elementary, middle, and high school), psychology, child development, social work, and special education.

UNITE Scholarship

Twenty "I am UNITE" in the amount of \$1500.00 will be awarded to high school seniors who are either UNITE Club members or have attended Camp UNITE.

Student must have been a member of a UNITE Club or a former Camper and/or Counselor for Camp UNITE.

GPA of 2.75 or better

Deadline: Applications must be returned to the address on the application by March 16, 2018.
