POLICY TOPIC DESCRIPTION

Eligibility Standards for Any Student Involved in Athletics at Harlan County High School

POLICY STATEMENT

Requirements a student must meet to be eligible to participate in athletics at Harlan County High School include the following:

1. Students shall not be found failing any class during a trimester in which they participate in athletics. Grades will be checked by the Athletic Director or Designated Teacher (s) starting on the THIRD Friday then every subsequent Friday from the beginning of school to the end of school. Any student found to be failing a class will be ineligible for one week (that would be Monday to Sunday). Students are eligible to return a week from Monday, at which time his/her grades will be reevaluated. In case of prolonged school closure due to inclement weather, eligibility will be reevaluated when school is back in session.
2. All students involved in athletics must take home and return a signed academic performance contract. This contract is an agreement between the student, the school, and the student's parents.

The Principal has the right to review each case on an individual basis, taking into consideration the student's previous disciplinary record, academic achievement, and attendance. Students who are suspended and removed from an activity have the right to appeal to the Principal.

This policy will be effective at the beginning of the 2015-16 school year
