If you are a regular education teacher who has even one student identified as gifted or potentially gifted that applies to you. Every year we are required to conduct a program evaluation and we do that through surveys. According to this year's surveys, 35% of teacher respondents think we do not adequately offer professional learning focused on gifted education and 34% percent believe teachers either do not participate or participate minimally. Our goal for the coming year is to increase participation in professional learning related to gifted and talented education. This workshop will review the requirements of regular education teachers serving the exceptional child who has been identified as gifted, provide resources for the identification of potentially
