Harlan County High School Coal Miners' Memorial Stadium Phase I Construction is currently underway. Show your support by honoring or memorializing your coal mining loved one or show your support for Harlan County Coal in general. The new stadium will feature a walkway with engraved brick pavers. In years to come you will be able to bring your children and grandchildren to the "Miners Walk" to see your family name as a permanent legacy of Harlan County Coal Miners' Memorial Stadium. These specially engraved, decorative bricks will be used to honor, memorialize and show support Harlan County Coal and our beloved coal miners. Everyone is invited to buy a brick (however many you want!) either for your self or for a loved one, or to honor Harlan County Coal in general. The proceeds from the sale of bricks go to the miners' memorial fund. Our goal is to raise enough money to place a plaque honoring "ALL Harlan County Coal Miners" and eventually have park benches, landscaping, etc. along the pathway.

## Brick Details

The bricks are \$100 each, standard paver size, 4"X8"X2" and are engraved using state of the art laser technology. The engraving is filled with hardened glass that is not subject to chemicals, acid rain, infrared and ultraviolet rays or sunlight- these bricks are guaranteed for a lifetime.

In addition, you will receive a miniature replica of the original brick. This mini brick can be used as a paperweight, given to a loved one as a remembrance or just as an everyday reminder! The mini bricks are 1 ½ X 3 X 5/8 inches.

## Deadlines:

February 15, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. will be the closing date for Phase 1. This is an on-going campaign and bricks orders will be accepted throughout the year after this date at a cost of \$125 per brick, however brick orders will be processed on an annual or biannual basis and bricks can only be processed in lots of 100 or more bricks. Please begin placing your orders now... each order is individual and we will review each for accuracy and call you if we have any questions.

## Engraving Information:

Each brick will have 3 lines of wording- you choose the first line to be either: In Honor of, In Memory of, or I Support "HC" Coal. The second and third lines have space for 20 characters per line including spaces and punctuation.
