Lynch Alumni Scholarships

Two scholarships will be awarded to Harlan County High School seniors valued at approximately \$1,000.00 each.

Deadline: Due to School Counselor in the guidance office no later than 2:30 p.m. on January 17, 2020.

Criteria:

- (1) Parent graduated from Lynch High School; or
 - (2) Grandparent graduated from Lynch High School; or
 - (3) Any connection to Lynch High School as in uncle, Aunt, cousin, etc. who graduated from Lynch
 - 4) Anyone living in the Lynch area.
- (Legal guardian (with documentation) may be listed for criteria 1-3.

Applicants must have a “B” average or higher;

Applicant should submit the following:

- 1) A Paragraph or short essay explaining the applicant’s connection to Lynch High School;
- 2) A listing of accomplishments, including clubs, activities, community service.
- 3) A paragraph on college and/or career plans;
- 4) Up to 3 letters of recommendation

- 5) A high school transcript;
- 6) A photo to be used for publicity purposes

Lynch High School Class of 1960 Scholarship

One (1) \$1,200 scholarship will be awarded to a Harlan County High School Senior.

Criteria:

- (1) Applicants should be related to alumni of Lynch High School or closely connected to the Lynch community. *(Please designate the name and class of the person(s) to which you are related or the years they attended the Lynch Independent School District.)*

Applicant should submit the following:

- An essay of no more than 1,500 words explaining the applicant's connection to Lynch High School or the Lynch community.
- A resume highlighting academics, extra-curricular activities, community service, awards and honors, and other highlights denoting merit to be a scholarship recipient.
- College and/or career plans. If you have not decided then list the top three post-secondary institutions under consideration and the top majors you currently are considering.
- Letters of recommendation from a minimum of one high school teacher or administrator and a minimum of one letter from someone outside the school or district.

- A high school transcript that includes grades and ACT scores;
- A photo to be used for publicity purposes

Note: School attendance and discipline will be considered by the selection committee.

DEADLINE: Due to School Counselor no later than 2:30 p.m. on Friday, January 17, 2020.
