Deadline: Must be turned into the guidance office by the beginning of 5th period on Friday September 24, 2021.

The Tony Turner Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: Must be turned into the guidance office by the beginning of 5th period on Friday September 24, 2021.

Criteria: Must be a senior who plans to pursue a career in broadcasting. Will be awarded based on talent and academics.
